



Minikit upgrade procedure

1. How to Upgrade a Minikit?

To upgrade a Minikit, there are two possibilities:

1.1. By Bluetooth

You will need a bluetooth USB dongle, a Windows-based PC and the Parrot Flash Update Wizard. In order to upgrade your kit, the following procedure must be respected :

- Make sure your bluetooth equipment is correctly installed on your PC.
- Switch on your Minikit.
- Download and install the Parrot Flash Update Wizard.
- Start the Parrot Flash Update Wizard.



- Click on Next.



- Choose the kit you wish to upgrade : Parrot Minikit.
- Click on Next.



- Click on « Download latest version »

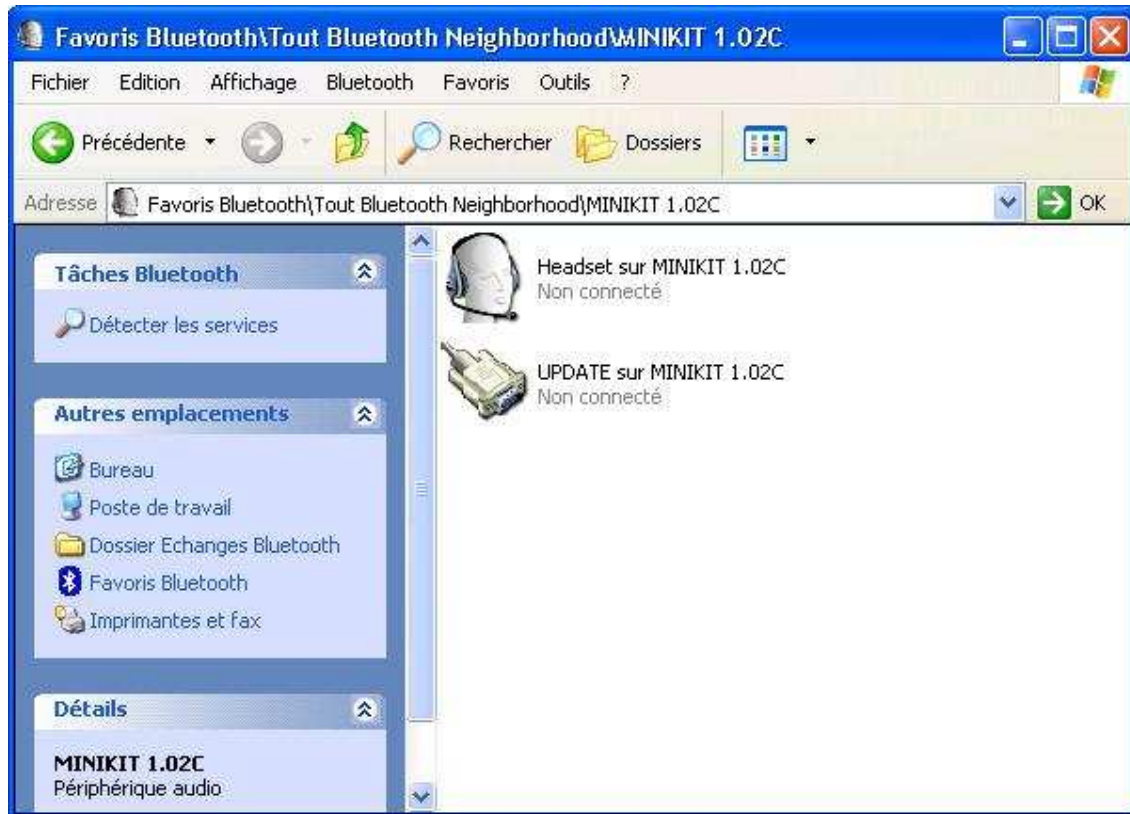


- Click on « Download now »
- Wait until the following window appears :



- Click on « OK »
- You can now disconnect your PC from Internet if you wish so.
- Click on "Browse" and load the files you just downloaded on your hard disk from the directory **C:\Program Files\Parrot Flash Update Wizard\Internet Files** (WARNING : for a bluetooth upgrade, you need to use the *.ulp file; the *.bin file is used only with serial cable upgrades).
- Click on Next)
- Start your kit.
- On your kit, enable the bluetooth upgrade option (turn the rotator until you hear « software upgrade by bluetooth ») .

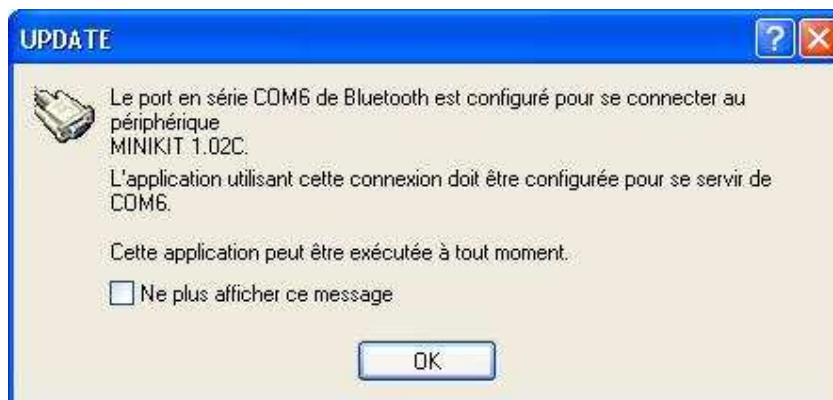
- Launch a bluetooth devices research with the software provided with your bluetooth dongle (or with the Windows bluetooth manager).
- Select your Minikit.



- During the bluetooth services search, two profiles are available : Headset and Update (SPP). Click on UPDATE.



- A popup message will display, click on it.
- Enter the bluetooth PIN code : « 1234 »
- Click on « Next »





- An outgoing COM port will be provided by the bluetooth software during the connection. Write it down, It will be useful (depending on the bluetooth software you are using, you may have to setup manually the COM port, please refer to the manual of your bluetooth equipmet for further explanations
 - In this example, the outgoing port is 6)
- Start the Parrot Flash Update Wizard.



- Choose "Bluetooth virtual serial connection".
- Click on Next.



- Choose the COM port you set up previously (the 6th port in our example).
- Click on Next.



- Wait for the Parrot Flash update wizard to complete every step of the installation.
- Click on Next.



- Click on Finish.
- Your kit is now up-to-date.

1.2. Other method (by bluetooth)

You will need a Windows-based computer, a bluetooth USB dongle (or integrated bluetooth device).

You can use this method only if you're using the Bluetooth manager provided with **Microsoft Windows XP Service Pack 2**. (If necessary, Uninstall the driver provided with your bluetooth dongle and re-install the Microsoft driver on the Windows update website).

To upgrade your kit, please use the following procedure :

- Make sure that your bluetooth equipment is correctly installed.
- Download and install the Parrot Flash Update Wizard.
- Switch on your kit.
- On your Minikit, enable the upgrade menu (turn the rotator until a voice says « software upgrade by bluetooth », then press on the rotator).
- Start the Parrot Flash Update Wizard.



- Click on « Next »



- Select the kit you want to upgrade : Minkit.
- Click on « Next »



- Click on « Download Latest version »
- Wait until the following window appears :



- Click on « Download now »
- Wait until the following window appears :



- Click on OK



- You can now disconnect your PC from Internet if you wish so.
- Click on "Browse" and load the files you downloaded on your hard disk from the directory **C:\Program Files\Parrot Flash Update Wizard\Internet Files** (WARNING : for a bluetooth upgrade, you need to use the *.ulp file; the *.bin file is used only with serial cable upgrades).
- Click on « Next »



- Choose « Bluetooth connection »
- Click on « Next »



- Click on « Search devices »
- Choose your Parrot kit.
- Click on « Next »
- Enter the bluetooth PIN code if needed : « 1234 » and validate.



- Wait until the end of the installation.
- Click on « Next »



- Click on « Next »
- Your Minikit will turn off. You can turn it on again.
