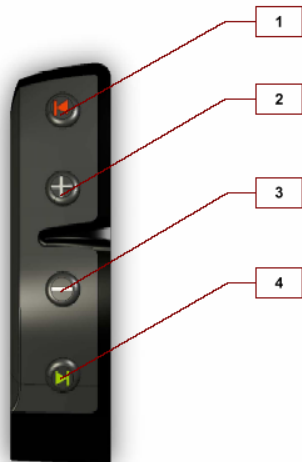

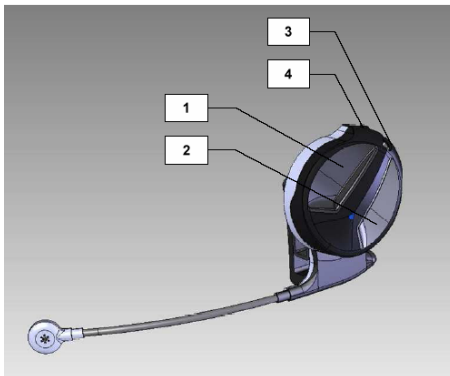

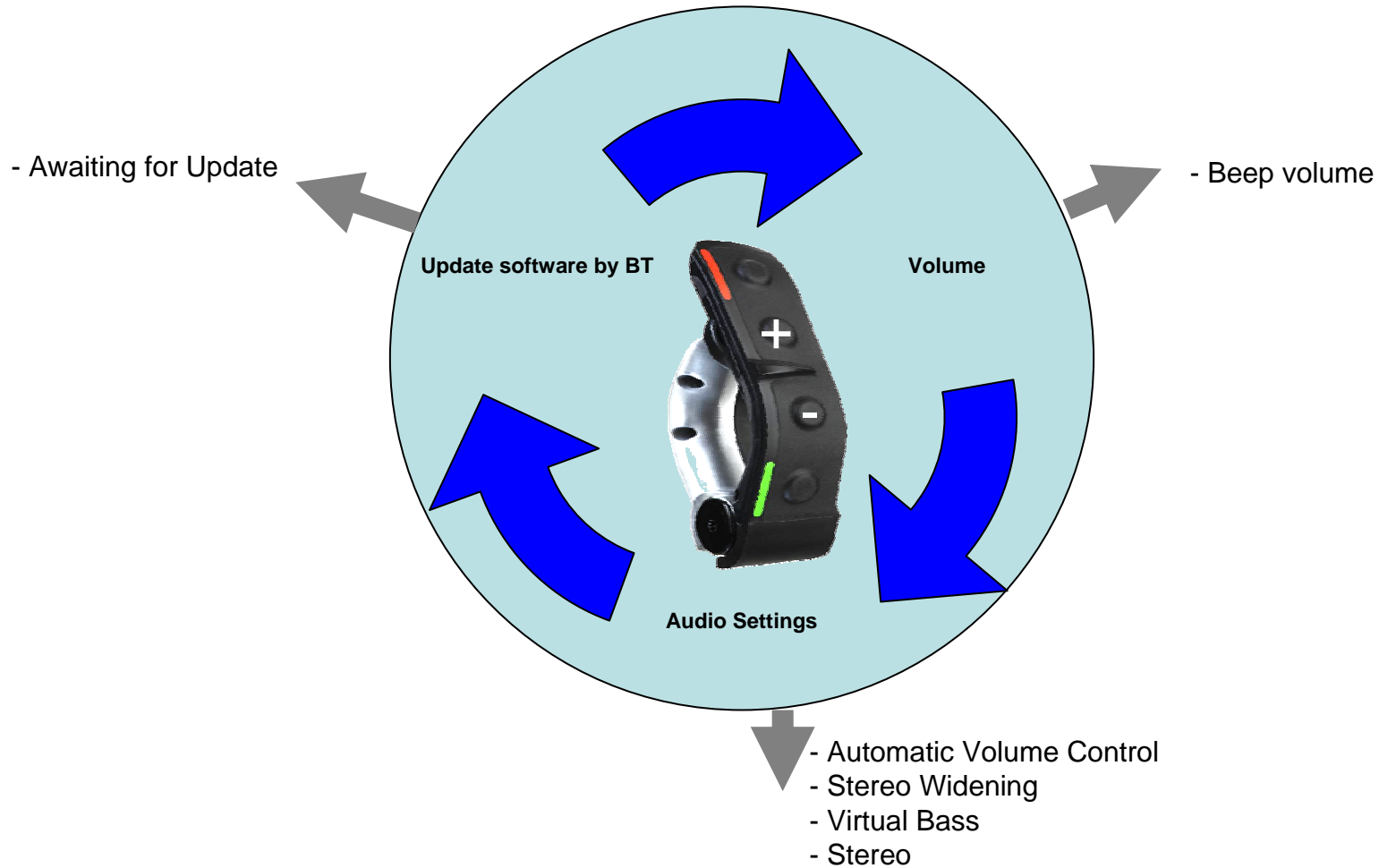
# Vocal Menu with phone connected



# Vocal Menu with PND connected

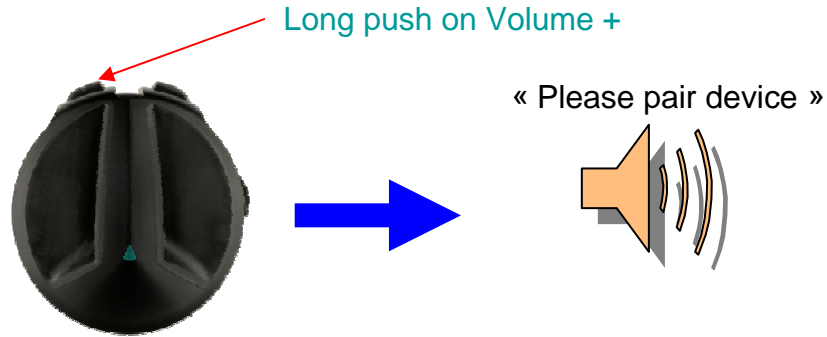


SK4000 has a special PND pairing, some menus are not available (Phonebook, voice tags...)

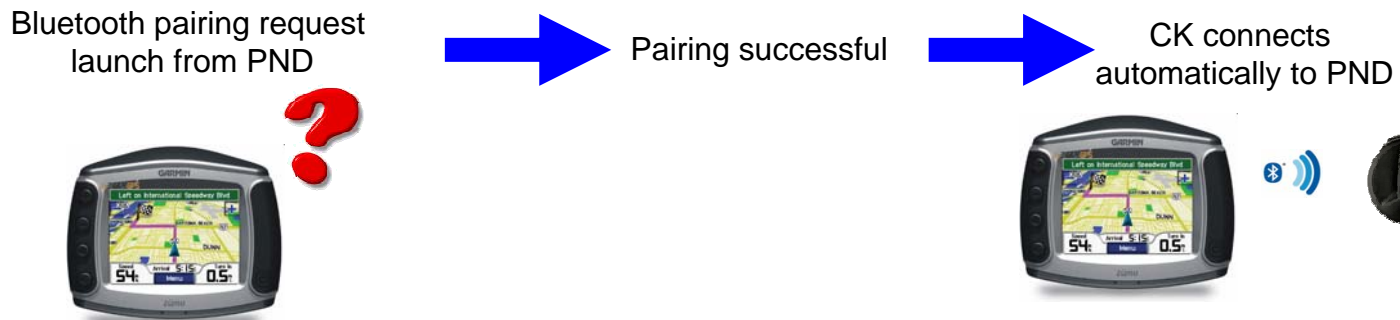


# Pairing Management with PND

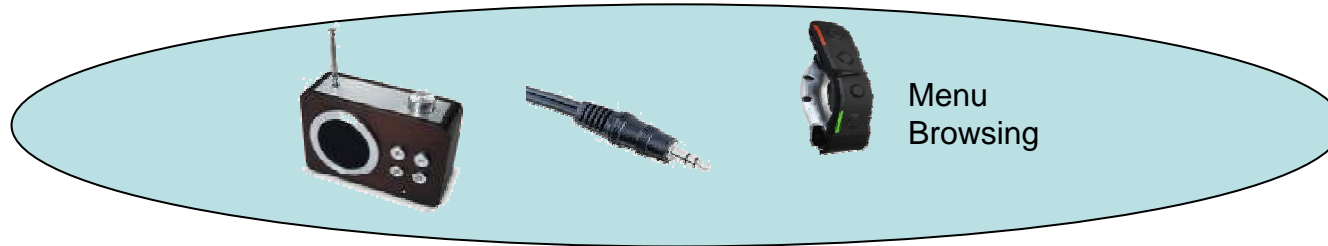
Step1- To pair a PND, you need to activate a special pairing mode



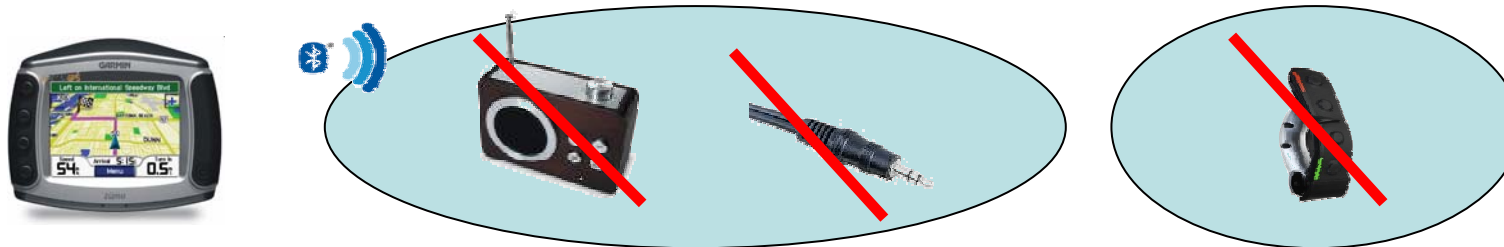
Step 2- The special pairing mode is activated during 3min



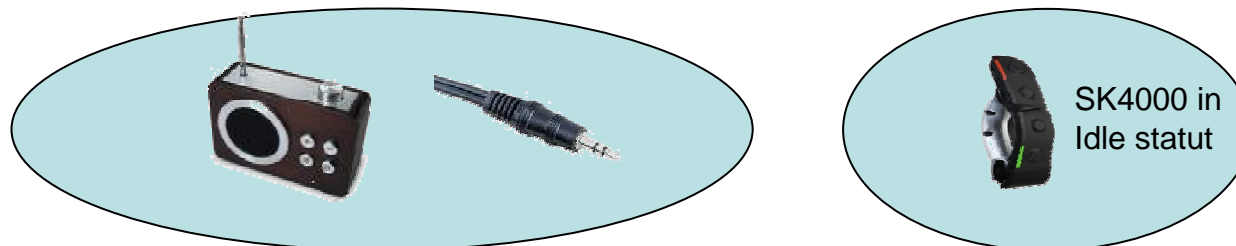
## Navigation audio message interrupt the initial source

## After the navigation audio message, the initial source is resumed (Execpt menu)

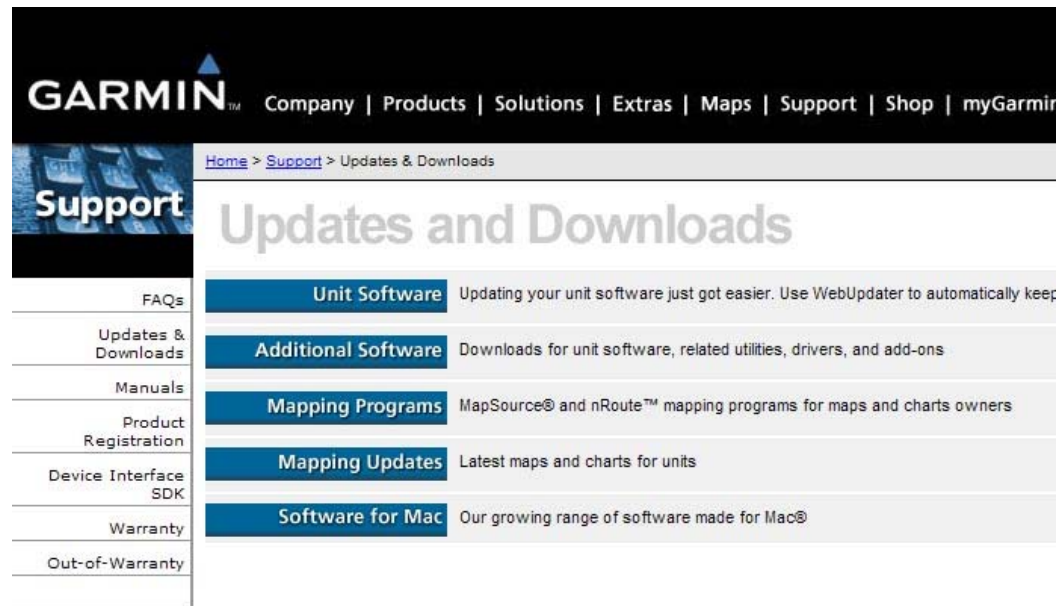
